## Arts of Pacific Asia Show

In 2008, Arts of Pacific Asia has been reduced to 72 exhibitors to accommodate the larger booths requested by exhibitors. The show is scheduled to coincide with the Spring auctions of Asian Material at Sotheby's (March 18, 19 and 20) and Christies (March 19, 20 and 21) and permit major collectors sufficient time to travel to Hong Kong for Asian Auctions scheduled for early April.

A number of new major exhibitors have joined Arts of Pacific Asia New York in 2008, including S Marchant and Son, specialists in Chinese ceramics; Knapton Rasti Asian Art, London, specialists in jade and Chinese ceramics; snuff bottle specialist Robert Hall, London; Chinese porcelain dealers,

Marchant & Son, London; Jan van Beers Oriental Art, London, specialising in Chinese objects; Chinese furniture dealer Nicholas Grindley; Georgia Chrischilles, Brussels, who offers jewellery and objects from South Asia; and export porcelain dealer Imperial Oriental Art, New York City. Regular exhibitors at the fair include from the US Eleanor Abraham Asian Art, The Asian Art Studio, The Jade Dragon, Arnold Lieberman, Marc Richards; Robyn Turner Gallery, Jon Eric Riis; Thomas Murray, l'Asie Exotique, The Tolman Collection, TK Asian Antiques and Watermoon Gallery. Soo Tze Oriental Antique, Australia; Wei Asian Arts, Belgium; Carlos Cruanas, Spain; Bachman Eckenstein,

Switzerland, Brandt Oriental Art, Jeremy Knowles, Nicholas Pitcher, Amir Mohtashemi and Joss Graham.

The opening preview evening is on Thursday, 20 March, from 6-10 pm. Tickets cost \$100 per person. The fair is open to the public Friday and Saturday, March 21 and 22 from 11:00 am to 7:30 pm, Sunday, March 23rd from 11:00 am to 7:00 pm and Monday, March 24th from 11:00 am to 5 pm. General admission is \$20 per person for the run of the show including the show catalogue.
